COVID-19 Update.

I attended the Heads meeting this week with Public Health, and Lewisham figures are that out of every 100,000 people tested, 29.4 are positive with Covid, whereas London is higher at 35.8. These figures continue to head in the right direction and thank you for continuing to following the rules.

On the reverse of this letter is a COVID-19 testing information sheet from Lewisham providing information about rapid testing and how you are now eligible to obtain these tests.
