More Christmas Cheer

Two Christmas requests from the Friends of Perrymount.

This is a final call for people wanting to take part in **Perrymount's Winter Windowland Trail**, which is being organised to raise money for the school and sprinkle some cheer around the neighbourhood from 6 - 27 December.

What's involved:

1. Participants decorate a window at their home in a wintery, sparkly, glittery way. It needs to be somewhere it can be seen by people walking by.
2. People who want to take part need to leave their name and address with the school office so we can mark all the addresses on a trail map, which will be available for sale to the children in December.

* Please note that names are only for contact purposes and will not be made public. Addresses will only be marked approximately with a number on the map.

3. Each window host will be given a number and a letter to display in their window. The number is how their address will appear on the map and the letter is part of a puzzle to be solved as people walk the trail.
4. The displays ideally need to be ready by 6 December and stay up until at least 27 December.
5. There is also an option to host a Hunters promotion board for the trail. Please let us know if you are happy to host a board - but this is entirely optional - you can host one if you don't decorate a window or you can decorate a window without hosting a Hunters board.

The school gets £10 for every estate agent board we agree to host.
